

MINNESOTA BALLOT QUESTION PETITION

“Each petition page must have a statement summarizing the purpose of the petition.” M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(D)

The language on the petition must be printed in at least 10 point type. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(B)

“I swear (or affirm) that I know the contents and purpose of this petition and that I signed the petition only once and of my own free will.”

ALL INFORMATION ON THIS PETITION IS SUBJECT TO PUBLIC INSPECTION

*****ALL INFORMATION MUST BE FILLED IN BY PERSON(S) SIGNING THE PETITION UNLESS DISABILITY PREVENTS THE PERSON(S) FROM DOING SO.*****

Each petition page must include the following statement “All information on this petition is subject to public inspection” M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(I)

“Each petition page must have a signer’s oath in 12 – point type. If the form of the signer’s oath is not specified by statute, the following oath must be used: “I swear (or affirm) that I know the contents and purpose of this petition and that I signed the petition only once and of my own free will.” M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(F)

Each petition page must include the following statement immediately above the signature lines: “All information must be filled in by person(s) signing the petition unless disability prevents the person(s) from doing so.” MR. 8205.1010, subp. 2(G)

The signer’s oath and the signature lines must be on the same side of the paper. M.R. 8205.1010

“Each petition page must have no more than ten signatures lines. The signature lines must be consecutively numbered. Each signature line must have space for the date of signature; a signature, and each signatory’s year of birth; printed first, middle, and last name, and residence address, municipality, and county.” M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(H)

The petition cannot be prepared on paper larger than 8 ½ inches wide by 14 inches long. M.R. 8205.1010, subp. 2(A)
