Dear Judge Eric L. Lipman,

As a Head Election Judge, I see upset voters who have documentation but not the one listed as acceptable in Minnesota. They do not understand why the documentation they present at their precinct is unacceptable to allow them to vote.

Adding the proposed documents is reasonable. I have personally had voters come with Wisconsin drivers license and a rent statement, a non-driver with a high school ID, mortgage statements and a residential lease. These citizens were turned away to

spend addition time searching for the acceptable documents.

Adding the following documents to the list of those available to prove identity or address for Election Day registration is reasonable and needed.

Proposed additional documents:

To prove identity:

1. Driver's license or identification card issued by *any state* (current rules allow only a MN license or ID card)
2. A student identification card issued by a MN *secondary school* (current rules allow only a postsecondary student ID)

To prove address (*For #1-3, the due date must be within 30 days before or after election day*)

1. Credit card and banking statements
2. Rent statements that do not itemize utilities
3. Mortgage statements
4. A residential lease valid through Election Day.
