WRITTEN REQUEST BY WRITE-IN CANDIDATES FOR FEDERAL AND STATE OFFICE

Instructions

For 2018, "Federal office" includes U.S. Senator and U.S. Representative. "State office" includes State Representative, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State Auditor, Supreme Court Justice, Court of Appeals Judge, and District Court Judge. Please note that if candidates for Governor and Lieutenant Governor are running as write-in candidates, this request must include the name of the candidate for Lieutenant Governor.

The 2018 Minnesota State General Election ballot will include two separate U.S. Senator offices. Those submitting a written request to have their write-in votes counted for the office of U.S. Senator on the 2018 Minnesota State General Election ballot must clearly state, as a part of the written request, the term ending date of the U.S. Senator office sought. The two office choices for U.S. Senator on the 2018 Minnesota State General Election ballot are :

- 1. U.S. Senator (Term ending January 3, 2025)
2. U.S. Senator (Special election for term ending January 3, 2021)
