This report covers the period from 1/1/2018 through 12/31/2018.

Community Hops' specific public benefit purpose is: Improving local communities, lessening negative environmental impacts, and connecting neighbors through education and training on urban gardening.

In 2018 our organization continued working to bring people together in the community to promote urban gardening. We hosted a number of events at our gardens and at other businesses in the community. Our two largest events continue to be the fall hops harvest and the Fresh Hop Brew Competition. At these events we brought together several hundred community members and other supporters of Community Hops to celebrate and learn about urban gardening, and to enjoy the fruits of the harvest.

During the growing season, we continued to host weekly work days in both North East and South Minneapolis, involving maintenance of the garden sites, plant care, and site improvement. These weekly work days also involved a number of educational opportunities for community members and supporters of Community Hops. Those taking advantage of educational opportunities gain experience in sustainable urban gardening and specialty crop care, and improving blighted urban areas with minimal environmental impacts.

We look forward to expanding our operation and exploring new opportunities to engage the public and partner with other civically-engaged businesses in the community.
