## Annual Benefit Report Jan. 1 – Dec. 31, 2018

OfferingTree's mission, as stated in our Articles of Incorporation, is to further wellness education and access. During the 2018 calendar year, we worked to fulfill our mission through four primary activities:

- Continuing to develop an integrated, easy-to-use online platform that supports wellness professionals in earning a livelihood and serving their clients' / students' needs
- Publishing educational blogs written by an experienced blog writer in order to provide useful and reliable information to wellness professionals struggling to figure out how to manage the administrative and business side of wellness
- Presenting at a holistic practitioners center on the topic of creating an online presence. This presentation focused on what wellness professionals needed to know in order to be successful based upon our research.
- Creating a free, online educational webinar, in partnership with a local actor and director, entitled Finding Your Story, which covers topics relevant to anyone interested in the art of storytelling or anyone who struggles telling others what they do and why they are passionate about it.

In 2018, our biggest milestone was launching two new tiers to our platform that included robust features, such as sending newsletters, creating custom pages, embedding video, adding a custom domain and selecting a custom color palette. Like last year, in October and November 2018, we focused energy on outreach educational efforts that included a presentation and creation of a new webinar (see above).

Since our team is small, we were hindered in our ability to offer a significant number of educational opportunities. In addition, our development timeline for the platform continues to be longer than expected given that our team works on a part-time basis. Finally, the ongoing costs of operating and building our platform necessitated that we change our pricing structure. Despite these challenges, we still managed to build new platform features and create educational opportunities for our users and the public

The OfferingTree team is excited to continue its work in 2019 to further wellness education and access.
