Striving to be a corporation that meets the highest standards of verified social and environmental performance, public transparency, and legal accountability to balance profit and purpose, the Board of Directors has selected the B Impact Assessment as the independent third-party verification system.

goodlandia, general benefit corporation has pursued general public benefit in 2019 by donating a portion of revenue to Simpson Housing Services, a Minneapolis-based nonprofit organization that houses, supports, and advocates for people experiencing homelessness.

Improving metrics outlined by the B Impact Assessment are a potential hindrance as a small corporation.
