## Annual Benefit Report Jan. 1 – Dec. 31, 2021

OfferingTree's mission, as stated in our Articles of Incorporation, is to further wellness education and access. During the 2021 calendar year, we worked to fulfill our mission through four primary activities:

- Continuing to develop an integrated, easy-to-use online platform that supports wellness professionals in earning a livelihood and serving their clients' / students' needs;
- Publishing more than 60 educational blog posts written by experienced blog writers in order to provide useful and reliable information to wellness professionals struggling to manage the administrative and business aspects of a wellness career;
- Presenting 16 free, online educational webinars in partnership with experts in the wellness space; and
- Sponsoring events and podcasts run by wellness professionals who provide training and educational content to other wellness professionals.

In 2021, our most notable successes included the launch of a new website builder tool as well as adding custom reminder functionality. Compared to 2020, we were also able to double the number of free, online education events that we offered.

Several circumstances hindered our efforts to advance our goals in 2021. First, our capital needs increased due to our larger user base, which meant our team spent considerable energy on creating a strategy to raise capital instead of focusing solely on product development. Second, our team recognized a need to develop additional features for a new user segment, which caused a reprioritizing of our existing product roadmap. Despite these challenges, we still accomplished two key milestones in 2021: launching a website builder tool and doubling the number of free webinars we offered.

The OfferingTree team is excited to continue its work in 2022 to further wellness education and access.
