Annual benefit report for Noor Companies

Noor Companies GBC and its Board of Directors have selected the B Impact Assessment (BIA) as its third-party standard for benefit reports. The BIA is governed by the non-profit organization, B Lab, and meets the statutory requirement that the third-party standard must be comprehensive, credible, transparent, and independent. More information about both the BIA and B Lab can be found at bimpactassessment.net.

For the reporting period of 2022, we hired more ex-offenders and created more affordable housing for families. We have also included more small businesses owned by people of color through our subcontracting, we have also co-guaranteed purchases for some of the small businesses that had no credit with suppliers and helped grow their capacity. Through our Noor Construction Group, we have included over 50% Small businesses and over 40% minority and or women owned businesses.

Pursuant to a general benefit corporation, Noor Companies' Board of Directors continues the following mission and vision as the standard to which it operates:

Mission Statement: To deliver high quality work while developing solutions that reduce economic disparities and to be an engine for economic inclusion for historically underutilized communities, workforce and businesses in affordable housing, construction and capital markets.

Vision Statement: Our vision is a world based on dignity, where every human being and every business has the same opportunity. Provide high quality work in construction, real estate and finance, while investing in underutilized communities, workforce, and businesses. Our goal is to lead innovation, services, products and technologies that directly reduce economic disparities and create empowered communities.

Pursued of Public Benefit: Noor Companies provides affordable housing, hires and creates an empowered workforce through workforce development and training in our construction company and through providing affordable housing and inclusive financial products in order to decrease economic disparities. In 2022 through Noor Development we built affordable housing residential units for ownership. We are pursuing several large family affordable housing multifamily products in Minneapolis. In partnership with public and non-profit organization we have hired approximately 12 individuals in construction with no construction backgrounds and provided on the job paid training paying \$28 an hour. We have increased our hourly pay from \$17 to \$28 to the population that we work with. Individuals graduated to jobs that are full time either in union or non-union fields with higher wages. Through our partnerships with public and private partners we are pursuing in creating the first financial product for communities that cannot utilize interest-based financing products.

Hindered Public Benefit: As a small corporation of one full time office staff outside of the field team that does the construction and training, we find ourselves lacking capacity to build the reporting and some of the metrics outlined by the B Impact Assessment. However, as our company grows, we hope to be able to tackle these challenges in the future
