


PERMANENT HEALTH CENTERS and MOBILE CLINICS

Our team has focused on adding features that will further enable quality care for patients in underserved locations in both mobile clinics and permanent health centers, including:

- Role-Based Security for added patient privacy
- Growth Charts to support pediatric teams to detect and treat malnourished children
- Exam Templates to streamline data entry for providers
- Upgraded Servers and Technology to ensure long-term, smooth usage for high-volume clinics

IMPACT MEASUREMENT

Ecotone Analytics created an Impact Measurement report for Binary Bridge, and we are able to show that for every \$1 invested in Binary Bridge, BackpackEMR provides \$6 of Social Return On Investment (SROI). We'll continue to measure our impact as we grow to further refine and validate those numbers.
