# In Minnesota, you are eligible to register to vote if you...

- Are at least 16 years old to pre-register and at least 18 years old on the day of the election in which you intend to vote
- Are a U.S. citizen
- Maintain residence in Minnesota for at least 20 days before Election Day
- Are not under court-ordered guardianship in which the court order revokes your right to vote
- Have not been found by a court to be legally incompetent to vote
- Are not currently incarcerated for a felony conviction



#### If you do not meet any of the criteria above, decline to register using the form on the other side.

## What you need to know

- People who complete an application at an eligible state agency and provide documentation of U.S. citizenship will be registered to vote automatically
- Register without a delay online at mnvotes.gov/register or at your county election office
- The deadline for advanced registration is 21 days before Election Day. However, you can register on Election Day at your polling place. Visit *mnvotes.gov* to learn what documents and identification you will need to register
- Certain voter registration information is public when used for elections, political, law enforcement or jury selection purposes. If you have personal safety concerns, you can keep your contact data private. Call 1-877-600-8683 to learn more
